AN ORDINANCE amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title IV, Zoning Code; Chapter 28, Zoning Ordinance; Article 28-5, Supplemental Standards; Section 28-5-50, Keeping of Chickens as Pets Accessory to a Residential Use

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

- **SECTION I:** Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title IV, Zoning Code; Chapter 28, Zoning Ordinance; Article 28-5, Supplemental Standards; Section 28-5-50, Keeping of Chickens as Pets Accessory to a Residential Use, as follows:
 - (a) <u>Henhouses and Fenced Areas Required.</u> All chickens kept or raised accessory to a residential use shall be kept within structures and fenced areas and not be permitted to roam free. Structures and fenced areas for chickens and manure storage areas must be located in side or rear yards and shall not be located within thirty (30) *five* (5) feet of any lot line.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
