RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$275,000) FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF OUTSIDE SERVICES TO RECYCLE SOLID WASTE AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF WASTEWATER FUND BALANCE FOR THIS PURPOSE

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the city's secondary wastewater treatment facilities produce solids principally from both physical and biological processes. After de-watering, the material is either landfilled, incinerated, or recycled; and

WHEREAS, Concord recycles about 100 tons of solid material weekly produced at its wastewater facilities; and

WHEREAS, the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services has recently adopted drinking water and groundwater quality standards for four per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS); and

WHEREAS, the adoption of these new standards causes the City to modify its solids management practices and anticipates annual operating cost that exceeds the current appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the department recommends that a supplemental appropriation of \$275,000 come from the Wastewater fund balance; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2020 adopted budget, therefore, Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1) The sum of\$275,000
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

Wastewater Fund
Outside Services\$275,000

- 2) Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

Wastewater Fund
Use of Fund Balance\$275,000
