Mr. Florence,

I am writing to request advice about how the leadership of Temple Beth Jacob, 67 Broadway, Concord, might pursue the designation of two permanent handicapped parking places on the street (Broadway) directly in front of the temple entrance. While we have a permanent "handicap access" sign, we have no dedicated permanent parking places.

During crowded temple events, we do use temporary signage to create parking access for the handicapped community, but it has been identified that the absence of permanent designated spots has created access problems on a regular basis to our religious facility. We have no offstreet parking. We do own the house directly next store to the temple (63 Broadway), which serves as residence for the rabbi of the congregation.
