**RESOLUTION** APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SIXTY-FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$64,188) FOR THE ANNUAL ROADWAY SURFACE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (CIP #78) AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF SIXTY-FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$64,188) IN RESIDENT GRANITE CURB COST SHARING PROGRAM CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THIS PURPOSE

## The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS, the City of Concord currently offers a granite curb cost sharing program to residents as part of its annual Roadway Surface Improvements project (CIP #78); and
- **WHEREAS**, this voluntary program allows residents to request granite curbing be installed along their property line when it abuts a street being reclaimed as part of the Roadway Surface Improvements project (CIP #78); and
- WHEREAS, payment for the curbing is received from residents prior to installation of the curbing; and
- **WHEREAS,** monies received for this program offset the cost of installing the granite curbing, as well as future paving expenses; and
- **WHEREAS,** this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2021 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1) The sum of ......\$64,188 be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

<u>General Capital Project Fund</u> Roadway Surface Improvements project (CIP #78)......\$64,188

2) Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:
