SUBJECT: NHDOT Municipal Work Zone Agreements

Recommendation

Accept this report authorizing the City Manager to enter into Municipal Work Zone Agreements with the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) for two interstate highway bridge painting projects.

Background

NHDOT policy requires it to seek municipal agreement when its projects impact the municipal road network. The agreements affirm that the NHDOT will have the responsibility to manage traffic control. The City has entered into these agreements for projects in the past.

Discussion

Attached you will find two agreements. The first is for the painting of the Hoit Road bridge over I-93 (Exit 17). The second is for the painting of the I-89 bridge over Clinton Street (Exit 2). According to the NHDOT, the work on these projects will take place primarily during the overnight hours to minimize impacts on traffic.

This work is planned for 2021.
