AN ORDINANCE amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title I, General Code; Chapter 14, Morals and Conduct

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title I, General Code; Chapter 14, Morals and Conduct, by adding a new Article 14-6, entitled <u>Use of Class</u> <u>C/Consumer/Permissible Fireworks</u>, as follows:

Article 14-6 - Use of Class C/Consumer/Permissible Fireworks

14-6-1 Authority

This article is enacted under the authority of RSA 160-C:6, which grants authority to municipalities to regulate class c/consumer/permissible fireworks.

14-6-2 Definitions

The words used within this ordinance shall have the same meanings as those defined in RSA 160-C:1, if any, whether as currently enacted or later amended.

14-6-3 Discharge of Fireworks – Hours

The display or use of class c, also referred to as consumer/permissible fireworks shall be prohibited in Concord between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. of each day.

14-6-4 Violations and Penalties

A person found in violation of this Article shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to the penalty outlined in Schedule II of Article 1-5, Fines and Penalties, of the Code of Ordinances. The fine for a violation of this Article shall be a maximum of \$500.00.

SECTION II: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title I, General Code; Chapter 1, Government Organization; Article 1-5, Fees, Fines, and Penalties; Schedule II by adding a new penalty under Chapter 14, Morals and Conduct, Section 14-6-4, <u>Violations and Penalties</u>, as follows:

Section 14-6-4, Violations and Penalties

Fine not to exceed.....500.00

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
