SUBJECT: Resolution for de-authorization of NHDOT Municipal Bridge Aid Program funds on Sewalls Falls Bridge Rehabilitation/Replacement Project (CIP #22).

Recommendation

Accept this resolution to de-authorize NHDOT Municipal Bridge Aid Program funds for the Sewalls Falls Bridge Rehabilitation/Replacement project (CIP #22).

Background

During the FY2020 Annual Capital Closeout, the 2012 Bridge Design and 2014 Bridge Construction sub-projects on the Sewalls Falls Bridge Rehabilitation/Replacement project (CIP #22) were deemed complete. City Council approved the Capital Closeout resolution (Resolution #9298) on June 15, 2020.

Discussion

During the processing of the approved Resolution #9298 dated June 15, 2020, it was determined that the de-authorization of the NHDOT Municipal Bridge Aid funds had been omitted. This Consent Resolution addressed that omission.
