SUBJECT: Intown Concord – FY 2021 City of Concord Community Grant Report

Recommendation:

Review the report submitted by Intown Concord and decide whether to release the funds appropriated in the FY 2021 City Budget.

Background:

During review of the budget that was proposed to City Council for FY 2021, the City Council expressed concern about the ability of Intown Concord to conduct many of the events and programs for which the City provides funding, due to the ongoing pandemic. Given that Downtown Market Days was already postponed/cancelled due to the pandemic, the City Council directed that the funds be held until information could be reviewed as to the potential revised use of the funds. The amount appropriated for Fiscal Year 2021 equals \$30,000.
