## **Recommendation:**

### **Background**

Phase one of the new Terrill Park Master Plan included building the first section of the Merrimack River Greenway Trail, new dog park and new upper parking lot was finished in September 2020. This project was funded in partnership with the Friends of Merrimack River Greenway Trail, the City of Concord along with a grant from the Land and Water Conservation Fund.

### **Discussion**

As part of the funded project we include an ad alternative to install water service to the new dog park. However, due to the cost of the project we did not have the funds to install the water service. The Concord Rotary Club then donated the money needed to install the line. With this donation we were able to install the water line to the new dog water fountain located inside the park. I would like to thank the Concord Rotary Club for their generous donation.
