RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, BY WAY OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY - LAW ENFORCEMENT OPIOID ABUSE REDUCTION INITIATIVE, FOR FUNDING DESIGNATED TO ASSIST THE DEPARTMENT IN CONDUCTING ILLEGAL DRUG RELATED INVESTIGATIONS.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS,	the Concord Police Department desires to apply for grant funding through the New Hampshire Department of Safety Law Enforcement Opioid Abuse Reduction Initiative; and
WHEREAS,	this grant program will provide funding for overtime costs associated with implementing strategies designed to address the illegal drug/opioid crisis facing the City; and
WHEREAS,	funding is available and the City of Concord is eligible to receive funding through the NH Department of Safety Law Enforcement Opioid Abuse Reduction Initiative; and
WHEREAS,	there is no financial match required for this grant program.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:
